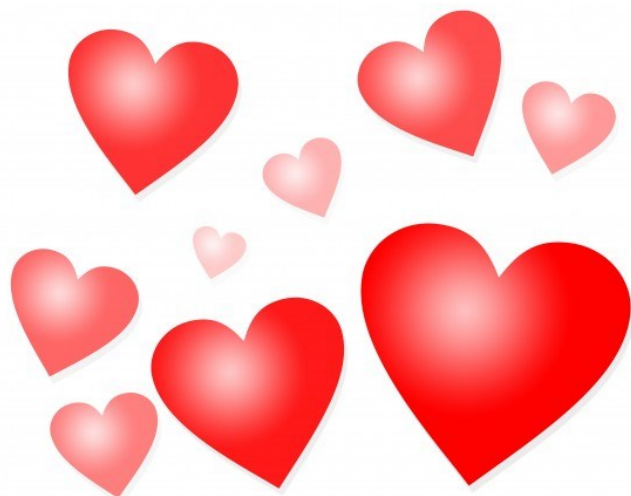
Women's Retreat:

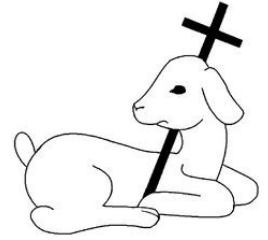
