FORMATION OF NEW MEMBERS CLASS

Every vital and growing church has an ongoing New Members class so new members and those considering membership may have a point of introduction, contact, and a place of welcoming to learn about Hatcher Church Fellowship. This class will provide a learning experience for new members and those desiring to know more about HMBC. This is a time to know one another and to become acquainted with the mission, ministry, and future vision of Hatcher Church.

A Peek into the New Members Class: This is a time for getting acquainted

We like to start with the broad questions: "Who are YOU......Who Are WE?"

In some ways, the answer to these question are straightforward. Practically, we can frame our identity in terms of our name, our home, our social status, our age, or by the activities that fill our day. Theologically, however, we can frame our identity as children of God. As people created by our loving God, claiming this identity emphasizes our common and constant place in creation. Everything else about us may change; this will not. At the very core of our being, we are children of God, created in the image of God. It is a skin we cannot shed no matter how hard we might try.

Understanding what that means, individually and in community with one another, can take time. Hatcher Memorial Church welcomes all who are willing to wrestle with that question. To do so is at the heart of a life of faith with Jesus. To do so is to step forward and say, "Here I am," and open yourself to what God might do next.

On the subject of faith, Frederick Buechner said, "Faith is better understood as a verb than as a noun, as a process than as a possession. It is on-again-off-again rather than once-and-for-all. Faith is not being sure where you're going, but going anyway. A journey without maps." For reasons such as these, you may hear people at Hatcher Church refer to "faith journeys." Your faith journey is less about what state you lived in or what church you attended there and more about what God was doing in your life during that time. Your faith journey may be filled with landmarks and road-side attractions, or wide open spaces. Your faith journey may feel full speed ahead, or parked and paused at a rest stop, or even broken down on the side of the road. It's all part of your Journey And we get through it together, by the grace of God. Wherever you are on this journey, you are welcome to travel with us. It is our prayer and hope for you to find Hatcher a safe and protected place and fellowship where you may continue to journey and grow in your relationship with Jesus and in relationship with new friends of faith.
