VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

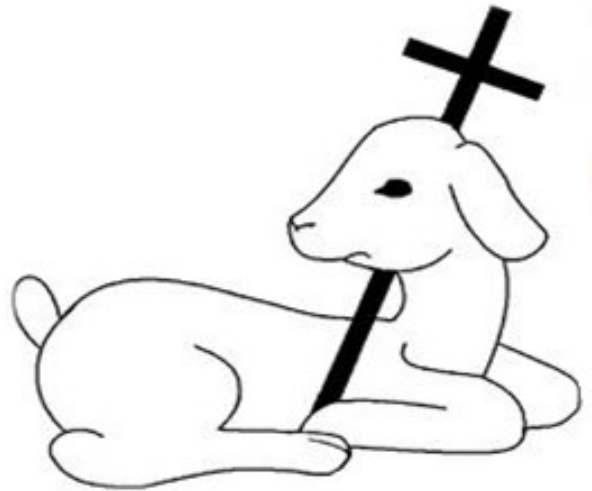
