Notice from the Deacons

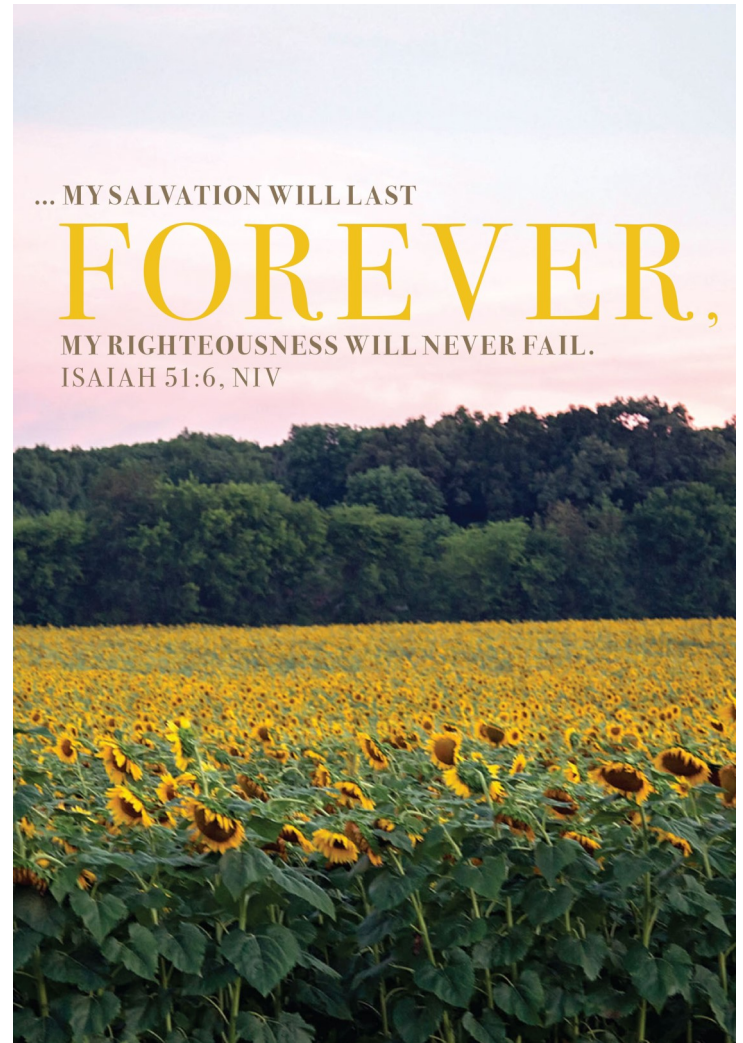
