





Update On Covid and Zoom Use



This past Sunday there was confusion about whether Zoom would be used for Bible study and church service. At a meeting this week with Pastor Sharpe, he confirmed that, at the June church council meeting, we discussed the prospect of discontinuing Zoom use. This was based on the Covid status at that time, which precipitated a renewed feeling of life returning somewhat to normalcy and of safety in in-person gatherings. Thus, a motion was made and passed to discontinue using Zoom starting September 1. However, since then we have seen an upsurge in the virus, and Pastor Sharpe felt we should continue

with Zoom use for an indefinite time, reevaluating the status on a monthly basis. Therefore, going forward, church services will continue to be available via Zoom until further notice. Bible study, however, will be available based on teacher availability. At this time, it should be available the first two Sundays of the month beginning at 9:45 (note earlier time). For the remaining Sundays, to simplify procedures, you will have to join the meeting via the link provided to see if it is available.

We are living in very unpredictable times, so much so that sudden status changes do not always allow the church enough time to inform members beforehand of changes we must make to adapt accordingly. Please be assured that everything possible is being done to keep our members and staff safe, while also trying to effectively communicate sudden needed changes so everyone feels appropriately informed. If you have any comments or suggestions, feel free to contact me.

Hatcher Endowment Fund News

Disaster assistance is one of the permitted uses of Hatcher Endowment funds. The Baptist General Association of Virginia (BGAV) is currently providing disaster assistance on numerous fronts including earthquake recovery in Haiti to catastrophic hurricane damage in Louisiana and Mississippi. The Endowment Committee voted unanimously to send a total of \$5,000 to the BGAV to be used for disaster assistance allocated as follows: \$2,500 for Haiti earthquake assistance and \$2,500 for hurricane recovery assistance.

However, we can still donate the kits which can be used for other situations, such as the areas recently hit with hurricane Ida and all the flooding in many areas as a result of the hurricane. So please continue to donate

through the month of September as they will still be used where needed.

Soap Shampoo Deodorant Washcloth

Toothbrush/toothpaste

Comb/brush Facial tissue
