What's the Difference between: Halloween, All Saints Day, All Souls Day?

For some churches, Autumn celebration doesn't stop with Fall Festivals or Trunk-or-Treats. October 31 actually begins a three-day observance and celebration called "All Hallows Tide" which is a combination of Halloween, All Saints Day and All Souls Day. Where did these holidays come from? Is there a difference between them?

What's the difference between All Saints Day and All Souls Day?

All Saints Day, Is celebrated by churches on November 1, and is set aside to honor church members who have lived faithfully and believed to have gone to heaven. Annually, we at Hatcher honor our members on the first Sunday of November with a special worship service of remembrance. This Sunday is usually a Communion Service when we remember our loved ones. who have passed during the previous year and especially recommit our lives to our Lord and Savior.

All Souls Day, November 2, (The Roman Catholic Dogma created this to commemorate those who died baptized but without having confessed their sins, and thus they are believed to reside in purgatory. Roman Catholic doctrine teaches that intercessions (prayers) by earthly church members can cleanse these departed souls and prepare them for heaven). We at Hatcher do not embrace this doctrine or special day, as it appears to be completely beyond the biblical example of the eternal resurrection.

Halloween, or **All Hallowed's Eve,** originated from ancient Celtic traditions that marked the last festival of light before the dark cold winter began. It was a time to ward off "Evil Spirits"; and this is where this day has often been thought to be an evil time when witches gathered and evil spirits were to be remembered.

Thankfully churches and communities now bring their faith in Jesus Christ to this time. Last year Hatcher had the opportunity to talk with over 500 families from our community at our Trunk or Treat! As we make plans for this year's Trunk or Treat on Sunday Afternoon in our parking lot between 3 and 5 p.m. on the 31st, it Is not too late for anyone to join us by decorating their car and enjoy a truly fun time to greet people in the name and love of Jesus.
