Sharpe Insight...

Advent is a Spiritual Season observed by the Christian Church as a time of expectant waiting and preparation for both the celebration of the Nativity of Christ at Christmas and the return of Christ at His Second Coming. Advent is the beginning of the liturgical year in Western Christianity, and is part of the wider Christmas and holiday season.





Scholars believe that during the 4th and 5th centuries in Spain and France, Advent was a season of preparation for the baptism of new Christians at the January feast of Epiphany, the celebration of God's incarnation represented by the visit of the Magi (The Wisemen) to the baby Jesus (Matthew 2:1), his baptism in the Jordan River by John the Baptist (John 1:29), and his first miracle at Cana (John 2:1).



The four Sundays leading to Christmas Day have a sequence of development and purpose: The First Sunday is the Sunday of **Hope**, The Second Sunday is the Sunday of **Preparation**, The Third Sunday is the Sunday of **Joy**, The Fourth Sunday is the Sunday of **Love**, The Center Candle, The Christ Candle, is lit on Christmas Eve.



Advent reminds Christians to remember and prepare for the birth of Jesus. Hatcher has a rich history for celebrating and experiencing the Advent Season. May we make this the grandest Advent ever as we fall in love with our wonderful savior all over again.
