A Way to Possibly Reduce Your Taxes and Benefit Your Church at the Same Time

If you are 70 ½ or older and required to take a distribution (RMD) from your IRA, this information may be helpful in lowering your tax liability, while benefiting our Church or other 501(C)(3) charity. If you are 70 ½ or older you can transfer up to \$100,000 annually from an IRA to a qualified charity tax-free. Listed below are some of the most relevant and important requirements that must be followed:

Most importantly, the funds must be transferred directly from your IRA custodian, payable directly to the qualified charity. If the funds are first distributed to you, and then you give them to the charity, they do not qualify for the tax exemption.

You must be 70 ½ or older.

The donation must occur prior to December 31 to qualify for the current year.

As with any unsolicited advice, you may want to confer with your tax advisor.





Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes: Most of the children that receive the shoeboxes have never heard the name of Jesus, they have never heard of God's great love for them, and they do not have the hope that is found only in Christ. When the shoeboxes are passed out in the different countries, the children and their families hear the Good News of Jesus in their language.

The supply list will provide 30 boxes for older boys and girls. Watch for school supplies to go on sale soon:

300 - #2 pencils (10 for each box)

30 - pencil sharpeners

30 - calculators - solar ones are best, as most cannot afford to replace batteries once they run out.

90 - glue sticks (3 for each box)

60 - highlighters (2 for each box)

30 - scissors - not the dull end ones since they are going to older children

30 - packs of 24 crayons

30 - packs of 12 color pencils

30 - spiral 1 subject notebooks - must be flexible ones so they fold over NOT the black/white composition hard cover ones - they don't fit in the box

30 - rulers - no more than 12" and need to have a little flexibility to fit in the box

30 - bars of full-size soap

30 - washcloths

30 - full size toothbrushes

Other items needed, if you wish to give these, are:

30 - pairs of flip flops (Dollar Store for \$1.25 - 15 boy colors and 15 girl colors - no larger than size 9 or they will not fit in the box.

30 - pairs of socks - 15 for older boys and 15 for older girls

300 - wooden clothes pins - I will supply the clothesline

15 - sewing kits (Dollar Store for \$1.25)

15 - sets of scrap material cut into 8" x 8" squares, a variety of colors - 15 or so squares per each set

30 - SMALL stuff animals - 15 more for boys and 15 more for girls

If you wish to donate money, it can be used for supplies or the shipping, which is now \$9.00 a box.

Deadline is now extended through August 28th
