In 2018, when Carol completed her Pastoral ministry for Bethlehem Baptist Church, we at Hatcher Church immediately pursued her and inquired if she felt God's leadership and be receptive in using her ministry skills by serving on our staff. She is presently serving as our Associate Pastor with special skills and emphasis in Out Reach Ministries, Administration, and Pastoral Care.

Prior to this position, Carol served as our Ministry Coordinator where she administrated ministries and missions of our church, coordinated the office management needs, organized the administrative direction for our committees and ministry teams, and established the Zoom meetings for our worship, Bible Studies, and varied committee meetings. In addition to her ministry skills, she preaches, teaches, and provides pastoral care to our aging congregation. Further, Carol supported our CDC as a Lead Teacher and Resource Leader. Presently, as our Associate Pastor, Carol is providing pastoral skills by leading several successful ministries for our congregation. She is serving

as Co-Chair of our Deacon Fellowship and provides leadership as our Church Moderator. While so many of our sister congregations are struggling under the stress of the Post Covid crisis, Hatcher continues to be revitalizing its ministries and is meeting and exceeding its ministry expectations.

She completed her Doctor of Ministry Degree from BTSR and is a called pastor with wonderful ministry gifts. The Personnel Committee was informed that due to present circumstances the Associate Pastor Position can no longer be funded and this position will conclude on July 31, 2023. Whereas, her position is concluding, she desires to stay a member of Hatcher Church and serve when given opportunities. Let us be in prayer for Carol that God will open the doors for her to continue in the pastoral ministry. Carol has come to this chapter in her life where she feels led to return to her Calling as a Pastor.


CA Day at Camp (Alkulana!
