The biblical purpose and primary call for every New Testament church is to preach, teach, minister, and share the redemptive love of Jesus Christ to all mankind so those without a relationship with Jesus will be drawn to His forgiveness and begin a saving relationship with him as Savior and Lord.

The secondary purpose is to provide a Community of Faith for discipleship, fellowship, praise, and strengthen personal and spiritual unity so new believers will be drawn into relationship with other like believing Christians and form a Church Family (Church) and help members to discover their spiritual gifts and provide opportunities for their gifts to be used in service and ministry to reach others for Christ.

The Foundation of a New Testament Church is to be reaching, teaching, and disciplining others for Jesus.
Everything a church undertakes needs to be evaluated on the basis of,
"How will this endeavor effectively reach others for Christ or how will this strengthen the members to become stronger disciples and witnesses?".

The Barometer for evaluating the health of a church family begins by measuring the "Market Place" where the church is planted and growing and then evaluating how effectively the mission of the church is reaching, teaching, disciplining, and sending others on missions for Jesus.

## Kitchen Information

Having shared some of the things I learned from my SafeServe class and hearing the request of getting some things in print for the use of the kitchen. As the committee gets together to come up with the "rules of the kitchen". Hearing this the first thing that comes to mind is, "Be careful what you ask for". Here are some basic things I hope all can agree upon to get the entire church
family on the same page regarding the church kitchen.
-All items in the fridge should be dated. For example, condiments
should have the expiration date and the date the container was first opened.
-There should be no "leftovers" left in the refrigerator. We need to remember that this is not our home refrigerator. Let us be aware that food left in the refrigerator begins to grow bacteria.
-All items in the cabinets need to be dated with the expiration date and date the item was opened.
-Everyone entering the kitchen need to wash their hands in the hand washing sink by the microwave. This sink is designed for hand washing only. Using the sink where dishes are washed is not to be used to wash hands. This prevents cross contamination.
-Dishes are to be washed and air dried. We are not to be drying dishes with hand towels. This prevents cross contamination.
-All counter tops, stove top, the steam tabletop, and floors are to be cleaned after each use.
-All trash is to be bagged and emptied after each use of the kitchen.
-All unused paper product supplies are to be put away.
-All food and product must be six inches from the floor. The wall storage unit in the kitchen may not have anything on the bottom shelf.

These are just a few of the "Kitchen Rules" that I hope we all can life with at Hatcher.

There is enough food in the freezer and cupboards to continue to cook meals for McShin and the church family throughout the month of June. The meals have been a blessing for our McShin partners. Every week it seems the number of people we feed increases. We fix plates until there is either no more food for the night or we have fed everyone in line. Allow me to pass on the expressions of the McShin folks: 'This is the best restaurant in town. Just sad it is only open for one meal a week.", "I look forward to dinner every week. Thank you for feeding me."

Let me also share a donation made to the Wednesday night meal service of $\$ 500$ from a father whose son is in McShin. His thankfulness of this ministry brought him to tears as he handed me an envelope containing a check. We are not doing Wednesday night meals for the money. I want everyone to be aware McShin pays $\$ 300$ a week to feed their participants. This amount alone covers the cost of the meals each week. The amount received above the McShin money comes from the church members who eat on Wednesday nights before prayer time and bible study. The church has not lost one cent paying for meals, just the opposite the church has received more money and more of what money can't
buy: BLESSINGS.
