### Why is All Saints Day a Special Time in Hatcher's Life?

All Saints Sunday is when our Hatcher Church Family remembers all of its loved ones and members who have passed during the current year. **During the 11 a.m. worship service this Sunday, November 5**, Hatcher will be remembering each person by name and recognizing the families. All Saints Day, also known as All Hallows' Day, or Hallowmas, is a Christian celebration in honor of all the saints from Christian history. In Western Christianity, it is observed on November 1st and the nearest following Sunday is All Saints Sunday.

All Saints Sunday comes from a conviction there is a spiritual connection between those in Heaven and on Earth. In Christian tradition, this day honors all people of faith who have passed on to the Kingdom of Heaven. Additionally, individuals throughout Christian history are celebrated, such as Peter the Apostle, Charles Wesley, Billy Graham, as well as people who have personally guided us to faith in Jesus, such as our relatives or friends.

"All Saints Day" annually reminds us of our connectedness as Christians. Perhaps, you were taught to think of saints as statues in a church building. But the Bible teaches something completely different. Who is a saint? *You are*; that is, if you're a follower of Jesus. God calls a "saint" anyone who trusts in Christ alone for salvation. See **Acts 9:13**, **26:10**, **Romans 8:27**, and **1Corinthians 1:2**.

Sainthood isn't given by a group of religious leaders. It's granted by God Himself to any common, salt-of-the-earth person who simply trusts Christ (1Corinthians 1:2). The gospel message is that Jesus came to earth, lived a perfectly obedient life, died on the cross to pay for our sins (1Romans 5:1), and rose again proving His atoning work was complete (1Romans 4:22-25). Saints are those who give up the anti-faith alternative of trying to please God by their good deeds and, instead, trust Christ alone.

This is a special time marked in our calendar year that gives us hope and strength for our future life with Jesus. This day of remembrance and celebration marks the beginning of our Thanksgiving Season. With grateful hearts for the gift of remembering our loved ones, this lays the foundation for what it means to be truly Thankful.

May you and your family this season experience the true joy of Thanksgiving for God's blessings,
