These meetings will provide a secure environment and offer an opportunity to learn how to identify those insecure feelings of loneliness and be drawn closer to the assurance of God’s presence and ever-present love.

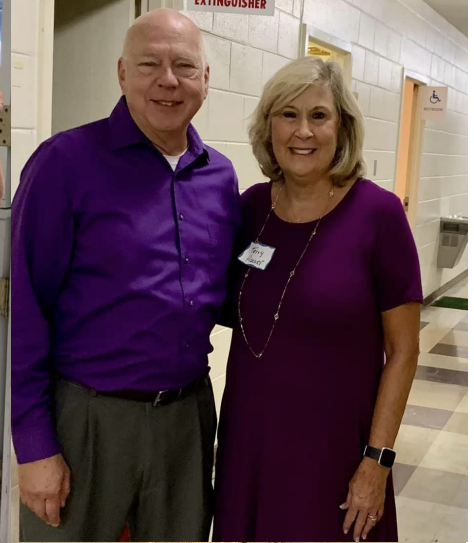
