## Pastor Search Committee

With Pastor Terry Sharpe stepping back into a transitional pastor role. It is now time for the Church to organize a Pastor Search Committee, information on this process is as follows:

#### How Hatcher Organizes to Call a New Pastor

A Pastor shall be chosen and called by the church whenever a vacancy occurs. The election shall take place at a meeting called for that purpose, of which public notice has been given in at least two worship services preceding the called meeting. An affirmative vote of at least 3/4 of those members present is required for a Pastor to be elected. The Pastor, thus elected, shall serve until the relationship is terminated by His or the Church's request.

#### How the Pastor Search Committee is Formed

When there is a Pastoral vacancy, a Pastor Search Committee shall be nominated by the Deacon Executive Officers and elected by the church to seek out a suitable Pastor. The recommendations of the committee will constitute a nomination. Any church member has the privilege of making suggestions to the committee for it's consideration. The committee shall bring to the consideration of the church only one name at a time. Details of the Pastor search process should be maintained in the Procedure Manuel.

#### **Duties:**

1. The Pastor Search Committee shall meet immediately under the direction of Deacon Executive Officers, select a chairman, vice-chairman, and a secretary to preserve records of the meetings. The committee should agree upon a time and place to hold regular meetings.

- 2. The Pastor Search Committee shall recommend salary, benefits, and relocation allowances for the new Pastor.
  - 3. The Committee shall report on it's activities at each Quarterly Business Meeting and monthly through the Herald or bulletin until a recommendation is made.
- 4. After an appearance of the prospective candidate before the church, prayer, and sensitivity to the Holy Spirit, the committee shall make a written recommendation concerning the individual to the church.
- 5. The Committee shall be automatically disband following the call and reception of the new Pastor.

It is with a heavy heart that I announce my resignation from Hatcher Memorial Baptist Church as it's Office Administrator. Hatcher has very much always felt like a home to me since I grew up within it's walls and the majority feel like family. Many of you have helped me grow into the person I am today and for that I will be forever grateful. Unfortunately, like Jesus himself once said in Mark 6:4-6:
