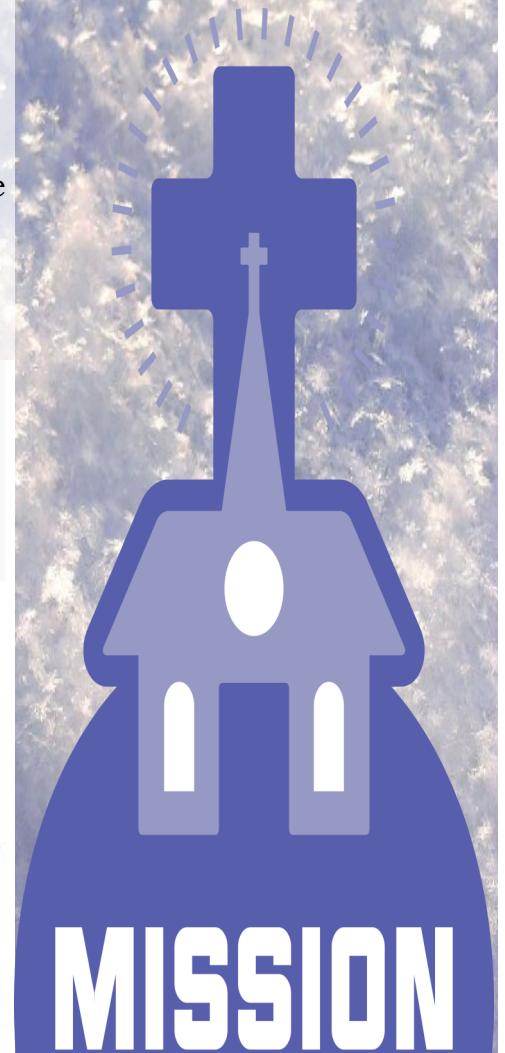
Love & Fellowship
