From Pastor Steve ...

What is faith?

We learn from the Bible, in the book of Genesis, that Abel offered to God what was acceptable, Noah obeyed God, Enoch walked with God, Abraham followed God. We learn that they were men who had faith. Their faith was in God.

The faith of the men and women listed in Hebrews chapter eleven took God at His word. Their reliance was not on themselves or in their "willing" something to happen. Their trust was in Who God revealed Himself to be and on what He had said.

1 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. 2 For by it the people of old received their commendation. 3 By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible. 4 By faith Abel offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice than Cain, through which he was commended as righteous, God commending him by accepting his gifts. And through his faith, though he died, he still speaks. 5 By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found, because God had taken him. Now before he was taken he was commended as having pleased God. 6 And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him. 7 By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith. 8 By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. (Hebrews 11:1-8 ESV)

Faith is only as strong or reliable as the object in which the faith rests. For example, we can have faith that difficulties in life will never occur to us, but that faith is not based in reality or fact. Jesus said, "In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." (John 16:33 ESV) We are not to trust for certain circumstances but in the One Who gives us peace in and through any circumstance.

Faith is believing. Faith is reliance. Faith is trust. The believing, reliance, and trust that God honors must be upon the Person, work, and Word of God.

Someone recently told me, "I want to go to heaven when I die, so I have to try harder in my life." This grieved my heart. My response to him was, "To go to heaven you have to trust in Jesus Christ. He alone is our righteousness. This is what God has told us in His Word, the Bible. Forgiveness and eternal life is a gift from God."

No amount of willing, striving, relics, chants, ceremonies, intentions, or any other human effort will gain eternal life. Forgiveness of sins and everlasting life is a gift. We either receive it or we don't. A gift is received, not worked for or purchased by us. The gift given to us has already been purchased. It was purchased with the blood of Christ Jesus the Lord. We simply receive His gift by faith. We trust His promise. He has said, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16 ESV)

Let us cease from our empty trust in ourselves in earning or somehow deserving forgiveness of sins and eternal life. Let us believe what He has said. Let us rely upon what has been written. Let us trust in what has been delivered to us from His Word. Let us, by faith, receive His gift, and then let us love Him and serve Him. Let us know that we live for Him, not *for* our salvation since we never do enough to earn it, but we live for Him *from* our salvation. He has loved us and rescued us by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ the Lord. Let us rejoice in this—in Him—with our lives, for His glory.



Let's all extend to them congratulations and a warm Hatcher welcome to the Diaconate! Thank you to these folks for agreeing to serve!



The members of the Endowment Committee want to express their sincere appreciation to you for your fifteen years of dedication and sound judgement in the oversight of the Endowment Fund. Your first priority was always the welfare of our Church and service to our Lord. During your tenure on the Committee the Endowment Fund distributed \$422,837 to fund Church projects and the fund balances grew from \$342,599 in December 2010 to the current balance of \$1,161,190. Did you know a QCD is an alternative for a required RMD from your 401K plan?

Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)

- What it is: A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from a traditional IRA to an eligible charity.
- Who can do it: Individuals aged 70½ or older can make a QCD.

Benefits: Tax-free: The amount of the QCD is excluded from your taxable income.

No itemization needed: You don't have to itemize deductions to benefit from the tax exclusion.

Counts towards Required Minimum Distribution (RMD): How it works:

The distribution must be made directly from the IRA trustee to the charity.
